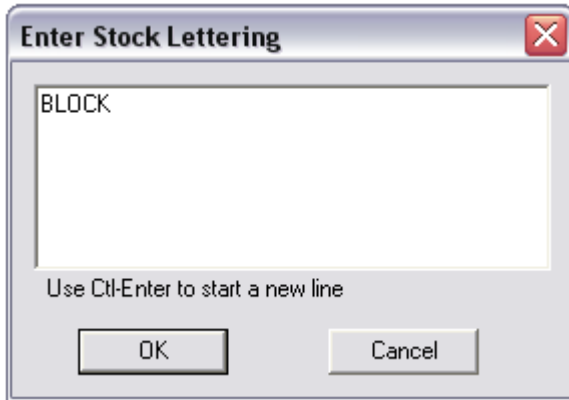

1. HOW TO USE 2 COLORS FONTS - NORMAL SATIN STITCH WITH SHADOW

STEP 1

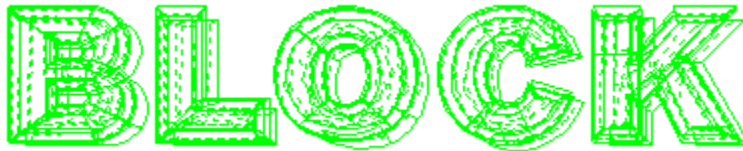
Enter the STOCK LETTERING. Key in the word (Example BLOCK)




STEP 2

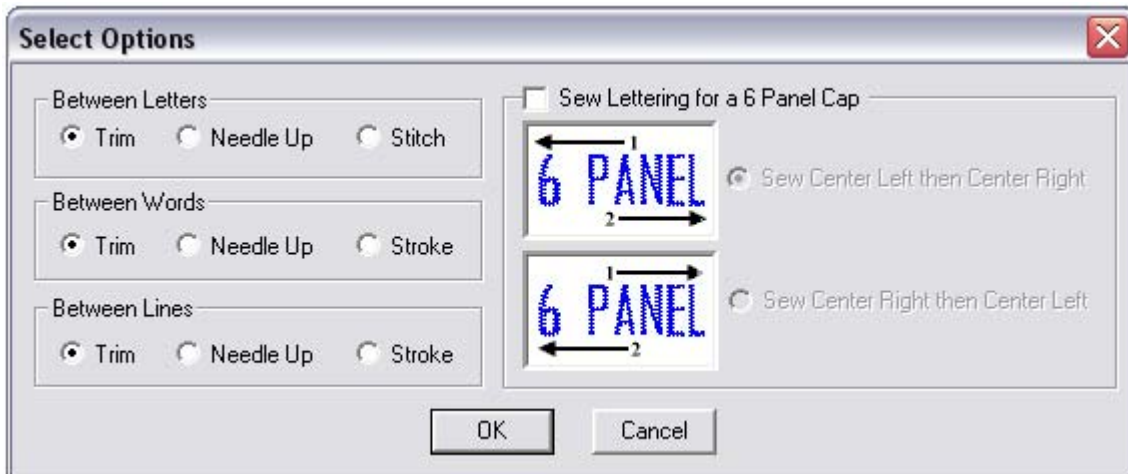
Click OK to confirm.

The below will appear on your Screen.



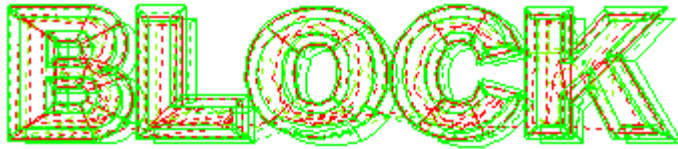
STEP 3

To Confirm click on Stock Lettering  again. The below Select Options Dialog Box will appear.



STEP 4

The below will appear on your screen.

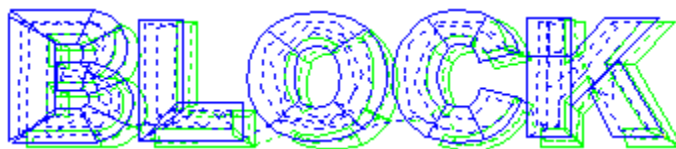
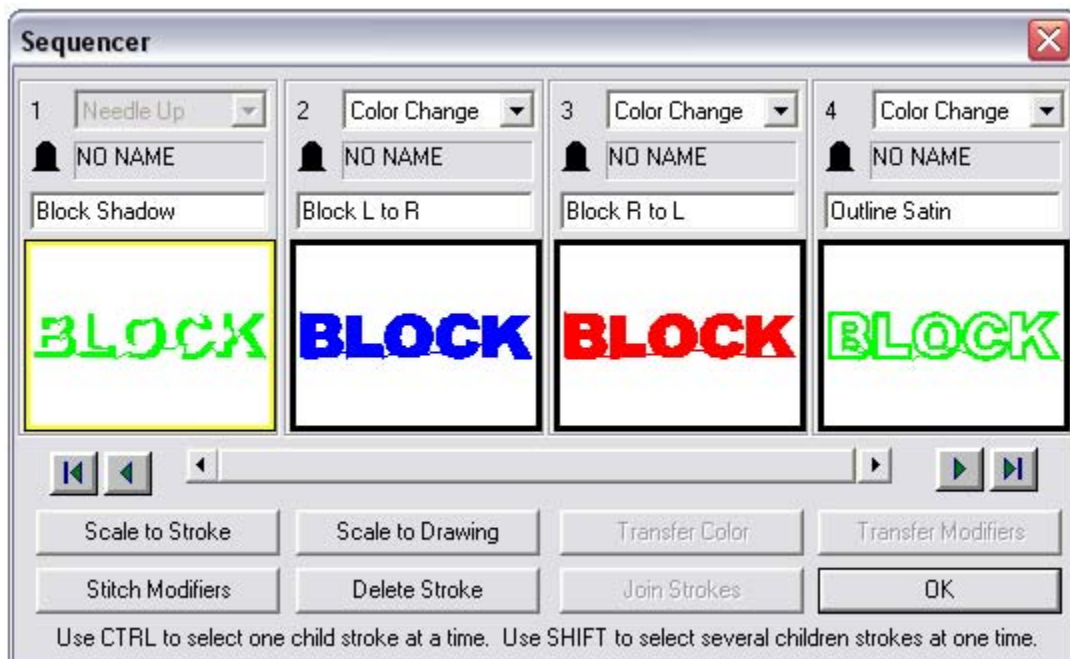


STEP 5

Click on SEQUENCER  Icon.

Delete Stroke Box 3 and 4

You will have **NORMAL SATIN STITCH WITH SHADOW** in SUPER BLOCK LETTERING.



This is **NORMAL SATIN STITCH WITH SHADOW** (Stitch Left to Right)

2. HOW TO USE 2 COLORS FONTS - NORMAL SATIN STITCH WITH SATIN BORDER

STEP 1

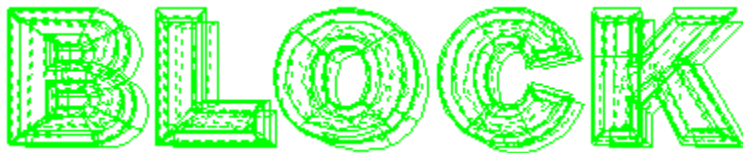
Enter the STOCK LETTERING. Key in the word (Example BLOCK)




STEP 2

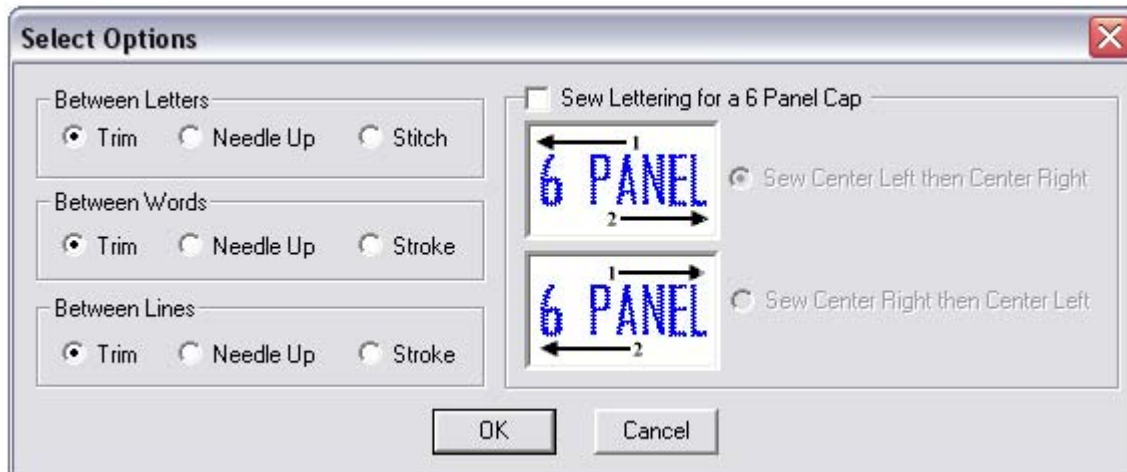
Click OK to confirm.

The below will appear on your Screen.



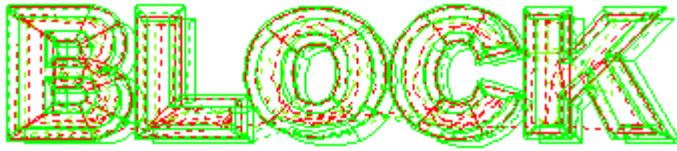
STEP 3

To Confirm click on Stock Lettering  again. The below Select Options Dialog Box will appear.

The below will appear on your screen.

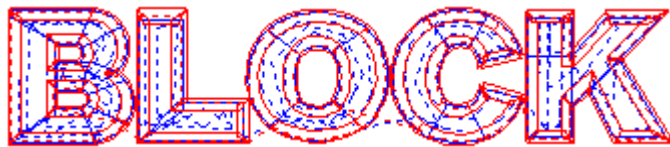
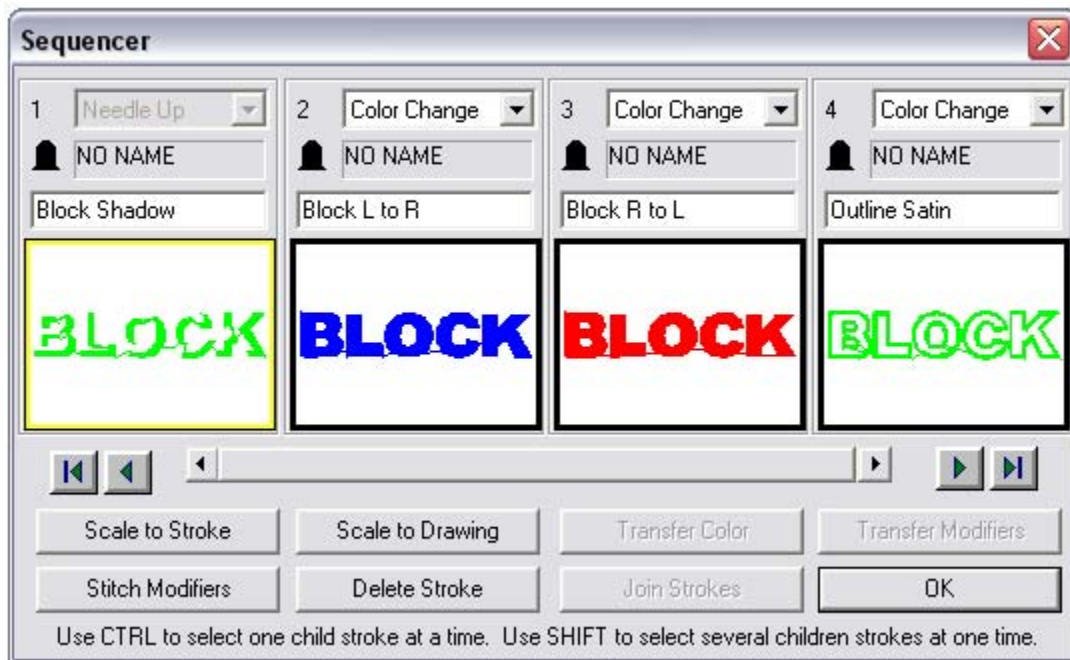


STEP 5

Click on SEQUENCER  Icon.

Delete Stroke Box 1 and 3

You will have **NORMAL SATIN STITCH WITH SATIN BORDER** in SUPER BLOCK LETTERING.



This is **NORMAL SATIN STITCH WITH SATIN BORDER**

3. HOW TO USE 1 COLOR FONT - NORMAL SATIN BORDER

STEP 1

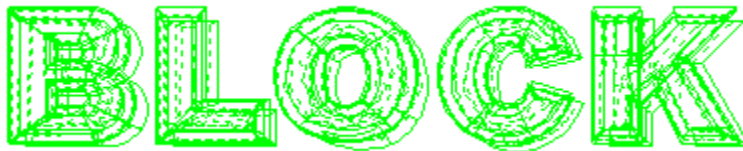
Enter the STOCK LETTERING. Key in the word (Example BLOCK)




STEP 2

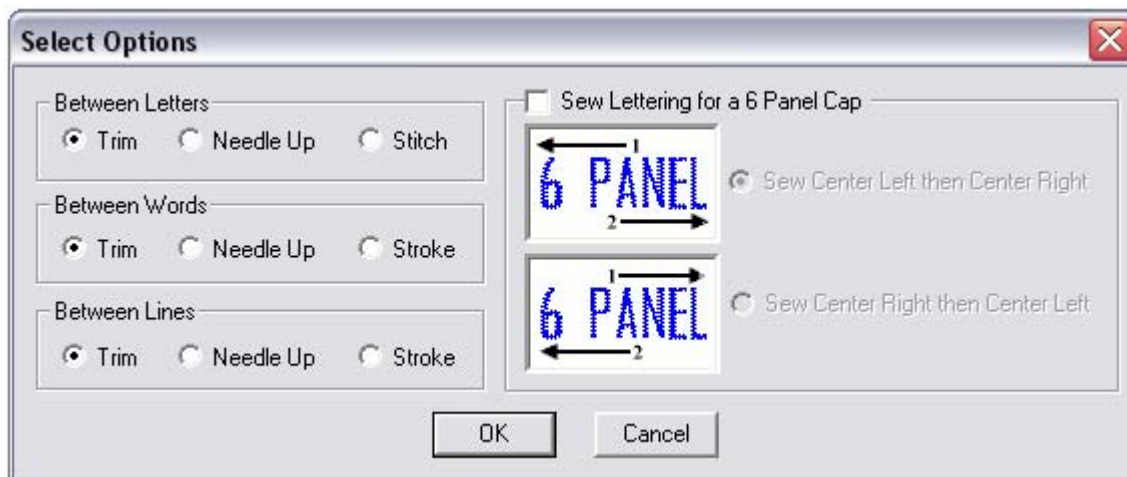
Click OK to confirm.

The below will appear on your Screen.



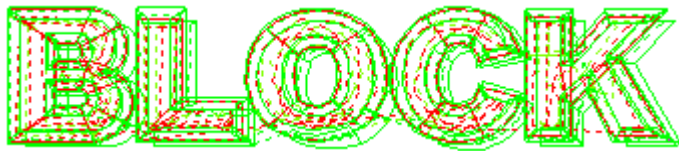
STEP 3

To Confirm click on Stock Lettering  again. The below Select Options Dialog Box will appear.



STEP 4

The below will appear on your screen.

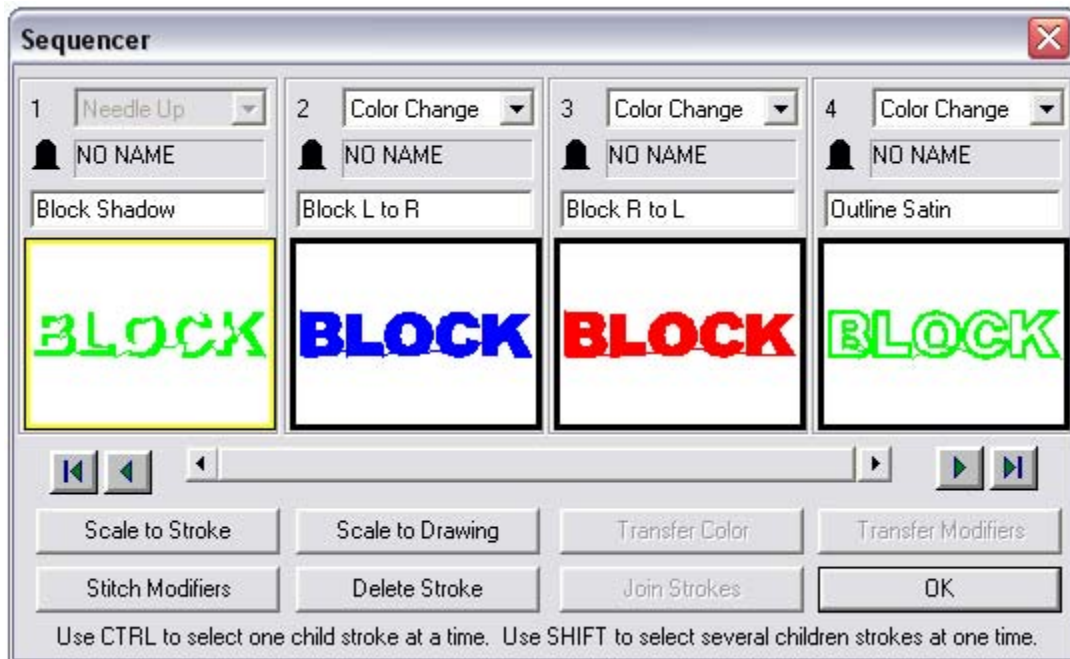


STEP 5

Click on SEQUENCER  Icon.

Delete Stroke Box 1, 2 and 3

You will have **NORMAL SATIN BORDER** in SUPER BLOCK LETTERING.



This is **NORMAL SATIN BORDER** (Stitch Left to Right)

4. HOW TO USE 3 COLORS FONTS - NORMAL SATIN STITCH WITH SHADOW AND SATIN BORDER

STEP 1

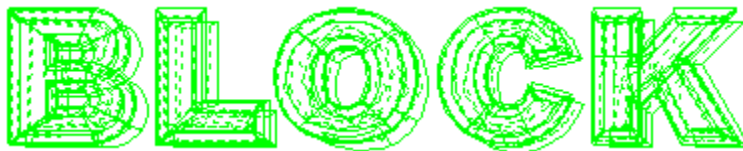
Enter the STOCK LETTERING. Key in the word (Example BLOCK)




STEP 2

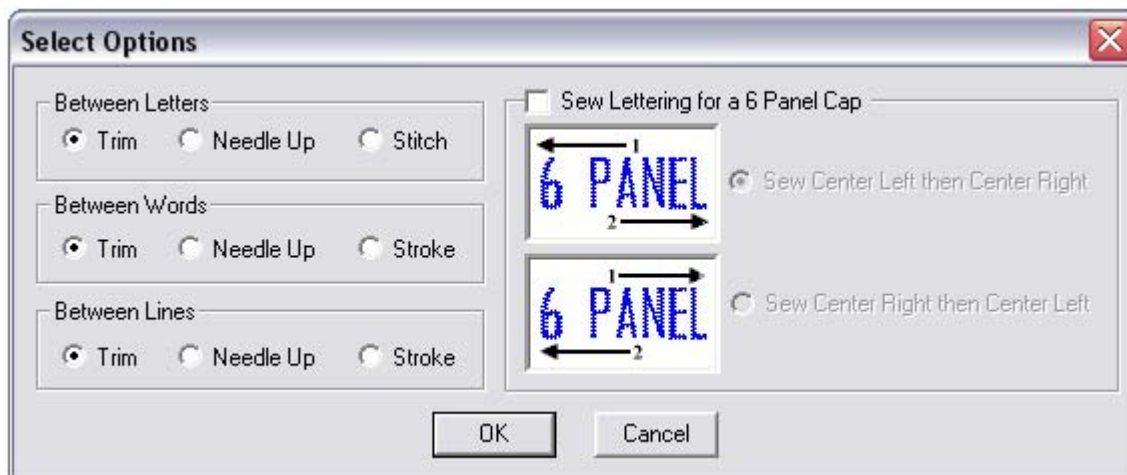
Click OK to confirm.

The below will appear on your Screen.



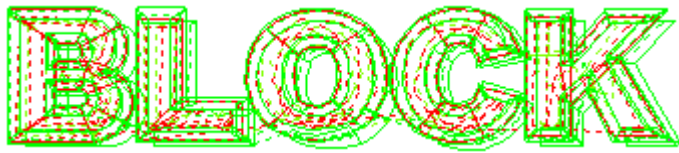
STEP 3

To Confirm click on Stock Lettering  again. The below Select Options Dialog Box will appear.



STEP 4

The below will appear on your screen.

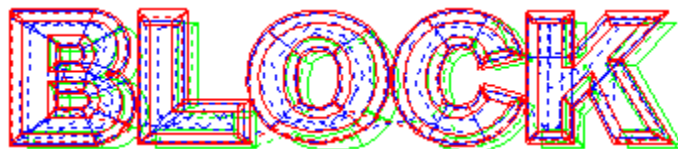
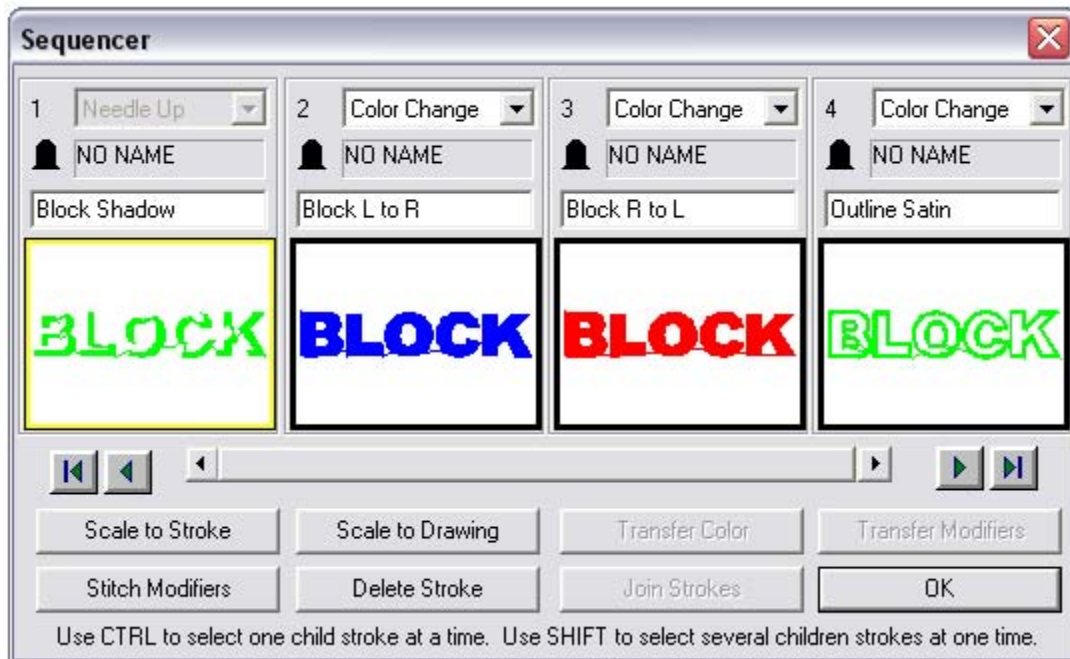


STEP 5

Click on SEQUENCER  Icon.

Delete Stroke Box 2 or Box 3

You will have **NORMAL SATIN STITCH WITH SHADOW AND SATIN BORDER** in SUPER BLOCK LETTERING.

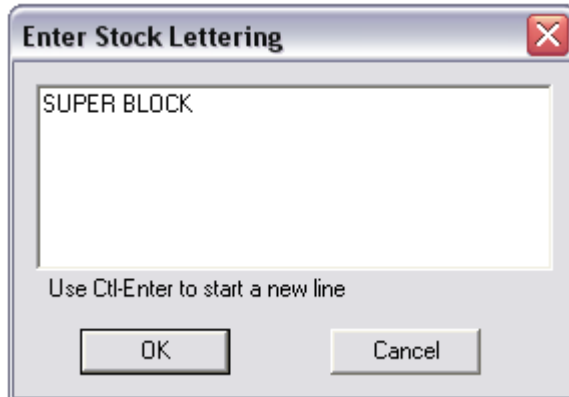


This is **NORMAL SATIN STITCH WITH SHADOW AND SATIN BORDER**

5. STITCH ON READY MADE **CAP** WITH SUPER BLOCK

STEP 1

Click on STOCK LETTERING. Key in the word (Example SUPER BLOCK)




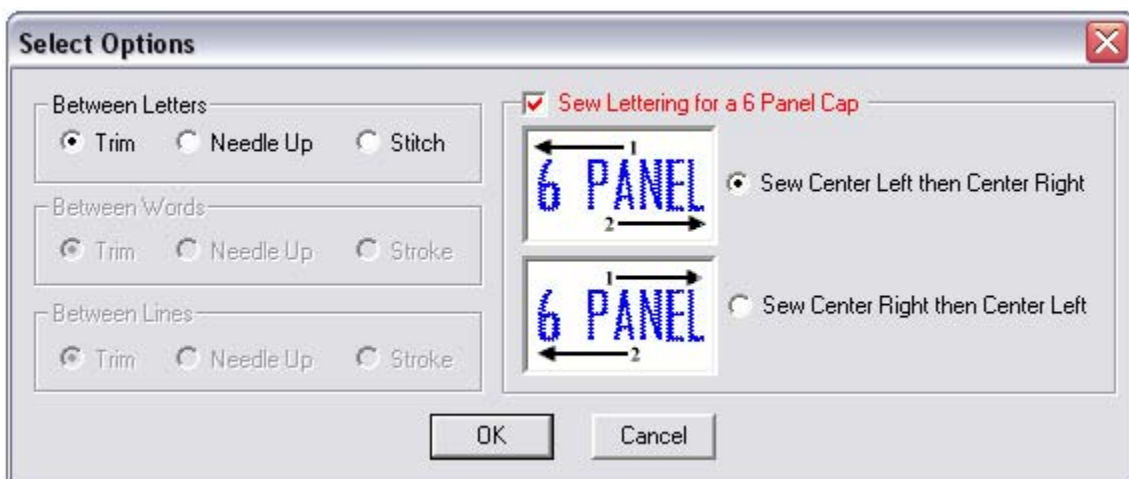
STEP 2

Click OK to confirm.
The below will appear on your Screen.



STEP 3

To Confirm click on Stock Lettering  again. The below Select Options Dialog Box will appear. Tick **Sew Lettering for a 6 Panel Cap**.



STEP 4

The below Image will appear on your screen.



STEP 5

Press on LAYER MODE  and NEXT LAYER  to display only one color in the design.

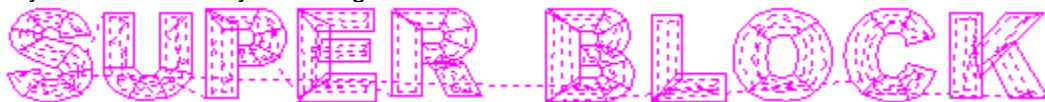
Layer A : Block Shadow



Layer B : Stitch Entry Point Left In / Right Out



Layer C : Stitch Entry Point Right In / Left Out




Layer D : Satin Border




Click on SEQUENCER  to delete stroke # 1 and 4.

Select the LAYER MODE  to display the color as below (Layer B).

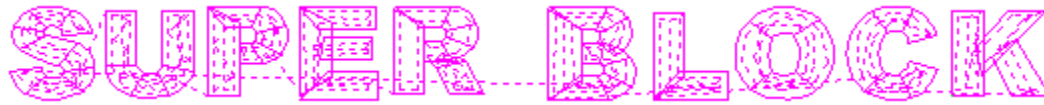




Click on ADD BLOCK WINDOW  . Using the mouse, then click and hold the left button down

and drag the mouse pointer to create a box around the word **SUPER**. Press CUT  to cut (delete) the **SUPER** . Now you will have only " BLOCK "




Press the NEXT LAYER  icon to display Layer C.



Click on ADD BLOCK WINDOW  icon, then click and hold the left button down and drag the mouse pointer to create a box around the word **BLOCK**. Press CUT  to cut (delete) the **BLOCK** . (Layer C : you will have SUPER word only)



Press the LAYER MODE  icon, the below will display on the screen.



This is the SUPER BLOCK Lettering to sew on ready made CAP.
Stitch from Centre Out. Start from **B-L-O-C-K** then trim and sew **R-E-P-U-S** without trimming on each letters.

BLOCK (Stitch Entry Point Left In / Right Out)
REPUS (Stitch Entry Point Right In / Left Out)

Note : And you can have

- a) 1 color **NORMAL SATIN BLOCK**
- b) 2 colors **BLOCK** with **SHADOW**
- c) 3 colors **BLOCK SHADOW** with **SATIN BORDER**
- d) 2 colors **BLOCK** with **SATIN BORDER**
- e) 1 color **SATIN BORDER**


with **Stitch Entry Point Left In / Right Out** and **Stitch Entry Point Right In / Left Out** all on the **NEW SUPER BLOCK LETTERING.**

6. 2 (TWO) LINES SEQUENCE

HOW IT WORKS?

Time Speed Up

How to Speed up your embroidery if you have a 2 or 3 lines word with Super Block Lettering?

SAMPLE :  SUPER (1ST Line), **Stitch Entry Point Left In / Right Out**
BLOCK (2ND Line), **Stitch Entry Point Right In / Left Out**


STEP 1

Enter the STOCK LETTERING. Key in the word (example SUPER)



Do it like Normal way...

STEP 2

Click on SEQUENCER  Delete the STROKE # 1, 3 and 4). The below will appear on your screen.



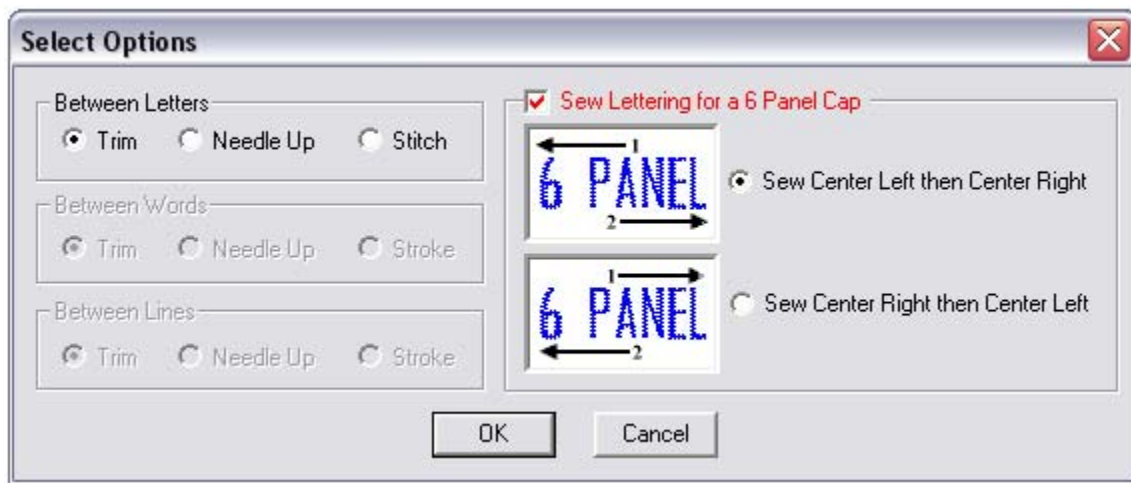
STEP 3



Enter the 2nd Line make 5 space-bar equivalent to 5 Lettering SUPER_ than key in the word **BLOCK**

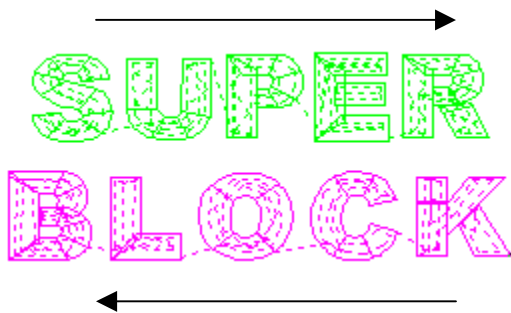
STEP 4

Click on Stock Lettering, the SELECT OPTIONS dialog box will appear and tick on Sew Lettering for a 6 Panel Cap.



STEP 5

On your screen the BLOCK word (Click on SEQUENCER  Delete the STROKE # 2, 4 and 5)



The SUPER BLOCK Word will stitch starting from stitch entry point **S-U-P-E-R** and followed by **K-C-O-L-B**)
So you have a faster embroidery.

Note : With the **NEW SUPER BLOCK LETTERING**, now you can have

- 1 COLOR **NORMAL BLOCK**
- 1 COLOR **SATIN BORDER**
- 2 COLORS **BLOCK WITH SATIN BORDER**
- 2 COLORS **BLOCK WITH SHADOW**
- 3 COLORS **BLOCK SHADOW with SATIN BORDER**
